**BIBLE TRUTHS**

**50. What is a miracle?** A miracle is an extraordinary event  
that shows God's power.

**51. What is the purpose of Jesus' miracles?** They showed  
that He was the Son of God. (John 2:11; 20:30-31)

**52. What is the Christian's purpose in life?** He is to put God  
first and do all things to glorify Him. (Mt. 6:33; I Cor.  
10:31; 6:20; Rom. 12:1-2)

**53. What should be the Christian's attitude in all  
circumstances of life?** He should be thankful to God. (I  
Thess. 5:18; Eph. 5:20)

**54. How should a Christian live?** The Christian should live in  
such a manner as not to bring reproach upon his Savior and  
Lord. He is commanded by God to separate from all  
religious apostasy, and all worldly and sinful pleasures,  
practices, and associations. He should avoid doing  
anything that displeases the Lord. (II Tim. 3:1-5; Rom.  
12:1-2; II Jn. 9-11; II Cor. 6:14-7:1; Jn. 2:15-17; I Cor.  
15:33; Prov. 6:16-19)

**55. What should we do when we sin?** We should repent of  
each sin and ask God to forgive us. (I Jn. 1:9)

**56. What are four important responsibilities that every Christian should fulfill?** In order to grow spiritually, every Christian should read and study the Bible, spend time in prayer, become a member of a Bible-believing church, and serve God in the church by using his/her talents and spiritual gifts to win people to Jesus Christ and help others grow in their Christian faith. (II Tim. 2:15; 3:15-17; I Th. 5:17; Jn. 14:13-14; Acts 2:41-42; Heb. 10:24-25; I Cor. 15:58; Prov. 11:30)

**57. Does God have a will for our lives?** God has a will for our lives that we can discover through Bible study, prayer, and yielding to the Holy Spirit. (Rom. 12:1-2; Eph. 5:17-18; Col. 1:9-12)
