• **BASIC MEMORY VERSES (All Grades)**

• **BIBLE TRUTHS**

21. How was Jesus born? Jesus was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. (Matthew 1:20,21).

22. What does the name “Immanuel” mean? The name “Immanuel” means “God with us”. (Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:22,23).

23. “What does the name “Jesus” mean? The name “Jesus” means “the LORD saves”. Matthew 1:21.

24. What does the name “Christ:” mean? The name “Christ” means “the Messiah, the Anointed One.”

25. Why was Jesus Christ able to pay for our sins? Jesus Christ was able to pay for our sins because he never sinned. (Romans 5:19)

26. How did Jesus Christ pay for our sins?

Jesus paid for our sins by dying in our place on the cross. (I Peter 2:24; II Corinthians 5:21; Isaiah 53:5,6; Romans 6:23; John 3:16; Hebrews 9:22)

27. Did Christ stay in the grave after His death?

No, Christ rose from the grave on the third day after his death. (Matthew 28:1-6; I Corinthians 15:3-4)

28. What important truth does the resurrection of Jesus Christ prove? The resurrection of Jesus Christ proves that Jesus Christ paid for our sins on the cross and that His payment was accepted by God. (I Corinthians 15:17, 20-22).

29. What hope does the bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ give us? The bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ gives us hope that some day we will have a glorified body like His. (I Corinthians 15:20-23, 42-29; I John 3:2,3)
