➤ **BASIC MEMORY VERSES (All Grades)**

**Nov. 7, 2010:** [Luke 6:31] Do to others as you would have them do to you.

**Nov. 14, 2010:** [Psalm 119:11] I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.

**Nov. 21, 2010:** [Psalm 118:1] Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever.

**Nov. 28, 2010:** [Galatians 5:13] You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love.

**Dec. 5, 2010:** [Matthew 5:44] But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you,

**Dec. 12, 2010:** [Colossians 3:23] Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters,

**Dec. 19, 2010:** [Matthew 1:21] She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins.”

**Dec. 26, 2010:** [Romans 10:9] "If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

**Books of the Old Testament**

➤ **BIBLE TRUTHS**

**49. What is justification?**

Justification is an act of God whereby He forgives the sins of the believer and declares him to be righteous because of the death of Jesus Christ. (Romans 5:1, 9)

**50. How does the Holy Spirit deal with the unsaved person?**

The Holy Spirit convicts the unsaved person of his sin and makes it possible for him to believe in Jesus Christ. (John 16:8, 9; 15:26; 3:3-6)

**51. How does the Holy Spirit help the Christian?**

The Holy Spirit baptizes, indwells, purifies, teaches, guides, and empowers the Christian. (Ephesians 4:30; 1 Corinthians 12:13; 6:19; John 16:13; 14:26; 2 Corinthians 2:14; Acts 1:8)

**52. What is sanctification?**

Sanctification is the work of the Holy Spirit within the believer, enabling him more and more to “put off” sin and “put on” righteousness. (Philippians 2:12,13; Ephesians 4:22-32)

**53. What access do believers have to God?**

Believers have access to God through Jesus Christ, the only mediator between God and man. (1 Timothy 2:5; Ephesians 2:18; John 14:6)

**54. What is prayer?**

Prayer is talking to God. (Philippians 4:6; Hebrews 4:16)

**55. In what manner are we to pray?**

We are to pray to God the Father in the name of Jesus Christ as we are guided by the Holy Spirit. (Hebrews 11:6; John 14:6, 13, 14; Ephesians 5:18; Romans 8:26)

**56. What should be the content of our prayers?**

Our prayers should include words of praise, confession, thanksgiving, and petition.

➤ **EXTRA MEMORY VERSES (4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> Grades)**

**Nov. 7, 2010: [1 John 1:9]** If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

**Nov. 14, 2010: [2 Timothy 3:16]** All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness,

**Nov. 21, 2010: [Psalm 126:3]** The LORD has done great things for us, and we are filled with joy.

**Nov. 28, 2010: [1 Corinthians 4:2]** Now it is required that those who have been given a trust must prove faithful.

**Dec. 5, 2010: [Nahum 1:7]** The LORD is good, a refuge in times of trouble. He cares for those who trust in him,

**Dec. 12, 2010: [Isaiah 45:5]** I am the LORD, and there is no other; apart from me there is no God. I will strengthen you, though you have not acknowledged me,

**Dec. 19, 2010: [Luke 2:11]** Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord.

**Dec. 26, 2010: [Matthew 4:10]** Jesus said to him, “Away from me, Satan! For it is written: ‘Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.’”
